IAN UNDRESS ENLISTED UNIFORM: OVERVIEW

The enlisted and noncommissioned officers undress uniforms have many features in common. Both consist of a light grey tunic worn over a short-sleeve, scarlet mock turtle-neck. For enlisted personnel, light grey trousers and boots complete the uniform. For NCOs, the trousers and boots are a darker gray, with a 5/8" stripe down the outer leg to indicate which division they belong to. The tunic has a low cut collar and black trim with shallow pockets. Rating insignia is worn high on both arms, just below the shoulder. A nametag is on the left side.

IAN UNDRESS ENLISTED UNIFORM: THE TUNIC

The enlisted and noncommissioned officers undress uniforms have many features in common. Both consist of a light grey tunic worn over a short-sleeve, scarlet mock turtle-neck.

Notes:

- (1) A short-sleeve, scarlet mock turtle-neck is worn underneath and therefore no scarlet pops out of the cuffs at the end as originally seen in the SITS2 drawings. Rather, the end of the tunic cuff is a thin bead of black that matches the black trim of the jacket.
- (2) The color-coding reference on the cuff, which SITS2 places on the undershirt, not on the jacket, has also been eliminated.








SITS2 Drawing. Note the original red cuff has been eliminated by BuNine.

IAN UNDRESS ENLISTED UNIFORM: THE PANTS

For enlisted personnel, light grey trousers and boots complete the uniform. For NCOs, the trousers and boots are a darker gray, with a 5/8'' stripe down the outer leg to indicate which division they belong to.

For NCOs, the 5/8" Grosgrain stipe is by division as follows:



Jr. Enlisted wear the light gray pants with no leg stripe. NCOs wear the dark gray pants, with the leg stripe.

Cap Badge

The cap is soft, and lower than that of the officers, grey with black piping around the top and with scarlet trim on the black band. An Andermani eagle cap badge is affixed on the face. Here is how the prototype cap came out. We'll have these available soon from one of our two external vendors.



You may choose to use a current rank pin for now.

A silver nametag is worn on the left breast of the tunic, followed by the name of the wearer's current ship.
